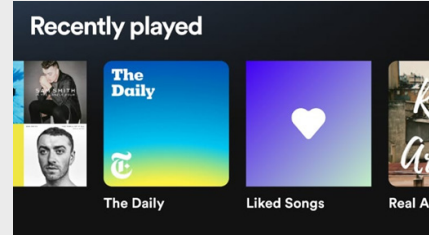

Find the Spotify app

- Find the Spotify app. You can look for it on your device's home screen.
- Tap on the **Spotify** app to open it
- If Spotify isn't installed on your device, open the App Store. You can search for Spotify and download the app. If you've never downloaded apps before, do [this lesson](#).

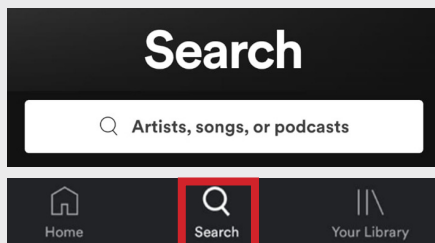

- If you don't have a Spotify account, tap **Sign Up Free** and follow the instructions
- It's best to use Spotify when you're connected to Wi-Fi because it needs an internet connection. You might have to pay money if you use your device's data plan instead of Wi-Fi.
- If you've never used Wi-Fi before, do [this lesson first](#)

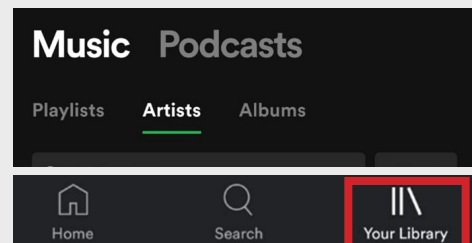

Search for music

- Tap the search button 
- Type the name of any song, album, artist, genre, or podcast you want to listen to
- Tap on a song to play it. While you're listening, you can tap play , pause , next song , and previous song .

Library

- Tap the **Library** button. You'll see any playlist, artist, or album you've been listening to.
- Try searching for your favourite musicians and play their songs to add them to your library
